With the ability to lock yourself into any mode you choose, you can prevent yourself from using cheats, or use blocks as a test build instead of always switching to creative mode. If you love to play with a lot of mods simultaneously, this mod can also solve any ID conflicts with its special ID Dump feature. Recipe Mode This mode is the reason this mod is used so often. With tons of recipes at your fingertips, it allows you to easily search the recipes by name or ID. You can also search for items in the same way just to get a look at them. To keep yourself from cheating, you can just lock yourself into this mode, and not be able to actually load anything. Utility Mode This mode adds two more features to the recipe mode function, allowing you to still search for recipes and items by name or ID. The additional features include Magnet mode, allowing drops to come directly to you (like a magnet). Delete mode gives you the ability to delete many options. Cheat Mode Although it sounds like a bad thing to do, Cheat Mode in Not Enough Items can actually be pretty helpful, without actually cheating. If creative mode gives you problems, or you just hate to switch between modes all the time, then you might want to give this a try to test out builds or items. Cheat mode basically allows you the ability to cheat the game by giving you unlimited blocks and items, change the time, the weather, and save inventories. You can also instantly switch into creative mode, or heal yourself to full health in survival. How to install Not Enough Items Mod? Last modified on Jul 5, 2021 in Mods by ApexHostingMinecraft is a complex game, featuring hundreds of different items and recipes making it very easy to get lost in keeping track of all of them. Add Minecraft mods on top of that, and it becomes downright unwieldy. The in-game recipe viewer can be of help, but it’s often clumsy to use and doesn’t contain many of the recipes added by mods.Luckily for us, there are mods to help with that! Many items and recipe viewer mods have come and gone throughout the years, but a notable name that has stuck around is NotEnoughItems. In this article, we’ll be describing NotEnoughItems, explaining how to install it, and how to effectively use it.Standalone or an add-on?Because of its development history, two distinct ‘versions’ of NotEnoughItems exist. The version for Minecraft 1.8 or lower can be categorized as a standalone, whilst the versions for Minecraft 1.9 and above are add-ons for JustEnoughItems, another mod with similar functionality.As a standalone version, NotEnoughItems is fully-featured — it has the search bar, recipe viewer, control panel and inventory saves, and it works on its own. It isn’t dependent on JustEnoughItems to function (in fact, JustEnoughItems doesn’t even exist for Minecraft 1.8 and below!), so there’s less overhead too.The add-on version is a bit different. As JustEnoughItems overtook NotEnoughItems in functionality and compatibility, most players switched to JustEnoughItems — but the trouble was, it didn’t have all the things NotEnoughItems had, like inventory preset saving. Because of that, NotEnoughItems 1.9+ is built as an extension to be added on top of JustEnoughItems, adding back those missing features.Server-side and Client-sideAlongside the standalone and addon division, there’s another important facet of NotEnoughItems to consider: its ability to function as either a server-side mod, a client-side mod, or as both.The terms server-side and client-side denote where, exactly, the mods run — whether on a player’s computer, on the server, or on both. If you have a client-side only mod installed on your computer, then that mod doesn’t need to be installed on a server, too, in order to be able to use it on that server.Such is the case with NotEnoughItems (and by extension, JustEnoughItems). If installed only on your own computer, it will run perfectly fine. Certain, small configuration features will be missing if it isn’t on the server as well — notably, selecting who’s able to use features like its creative mode toggle, weather control, magnet mode, and similar — but other than that, it will work absolutely fine.NotEnoughItems’ featuresNotEnoughItems features’ will depend on whether or not it’s installed as a standalone or an addon, as explained above.As a standalone, NotEnoughItems offers: Quick and easy item listing, with extensive sorting and searching options Recipe viewing Drag-and-drop item adding, if cheat mode is enabled An admin command panel, allowing you to change world/server parameters without typing in commands manually — gamemode switching, weather control and the like Saving and loading inventory presets Changing an item’s enchantments on the flyAs an add-on, NotEnoughItems enhances JustEnoughItems’ functionality. By default, JustEnoughItems already comes with item listing, sorting, searching, recipe viewing and item adding, but it lacks inventory presets and enchantment changing. By adding NotEnoughItems on top of JustEnoughItems, these missing features are re-introduced.How to install NotEnoughItemsIf you’re convinced and would like to give NotEnoughItems a try, getting it installed and working is pretty simple.The installation of NotEnoughItems will depend on a few factors — whether you want to add it to an existing modpack, or if you want to install it onto a fresh Minecraft installation, as well as the version of Minecraft you’re adding it to. It’s pretty easy, either way!As we’ve already established, depending on the version of Minecraft you’re getting NotEnoughItems for, it can be either a standalone mod or an add-on for JustEnoughItems.Downloading NotEnoughItemsBecause of the version differences, NotEnoughItems’ downloads will differ, based on the Minecraft version you’re getting it for. Minecraft 1.8 or lower Head over to NotEnoughItems’ download page ( and get the version you want. You can use the “Game Version” dropdown list to sort by Minecraft version. Download CodeChickenCore ( and get the version you want, similarly to how you downloaded NotEnoughItems. Make sure their compatible Minecraft versions match. Put these files in an easy-to-reach location. We’ll be needing them for later!Minecraft 1.9 and higher Head over to NotEnoughItems 1.8+’ download page and get the version you want. You can use the “Game Version” dropdown list to sort by Minecraft version. Download CodeChickenCore 1.8+ and get the version you want, similarly to how you downloaded NotEnoughItems. Make sure their compatible Minecraft versions match. And lastly, get JustEnoughItems if you don’t already have it. Put these files in an easy-to-reach location. We’ll be needing them for later!How to install NEI on a Minecraft ServerMake sure that your server is set to Forge under the jar dropdown. You can find a tutorial on changing server versions here. Note that you need to run forge before you put the mods in, to create the mods folder, and if you do not your mods will be deleted.Stop the server.To the left of the game panel, click on FTP File Access and go into the mods folder.Click on “Upload” then simply drag the Not Enough Items jar you have previously downloaded. Wait for it to fully upload before leaving this page.Once NEI has uploaded, head back to the main page of your control panel and restart the server.How to install NotEnoughItems from scratchTo add NotEnoughItems to an unmodded Minecraft game, you will first need to install Forge. Forge is a mod loader, and Minecraft won’t load NotEnoughItems without Forge present. If you’re unsure how to install Forge, we have a handy guide on doing so right here.After you’ve installed Forge, you need to open your Minecraft installation folder: If you’re on Windows, press the **W** Windows Logo Key + R, then type in %APPDATA%\minecraft and click OK. For those on Mac, press **⌘** Command + Space, type in ~/Library/Application Support/minecraft and press Enter. On Linux, issue the following command into the terminal: `cd ~/.minecraft` If you have already installed Forge and mods, then all you need to do is add the .jar files you’ve downloaded into the mods folder. If this is the first time you’re installing mods, you might need to create a new folder and name it mods, then drag-and-drop the .jar files into it.And that’s it! Once you’ve put NotEnoughItems’ and its dependencies’ .jar files in the mods folder, they will be added to Minecraft the next time you start it using your Forge profile.How to add NotEnoughItems to a modpackAdding NotEnoughItems to an already-existing modpack requires you to find that modpack’s installation folder, then drag-and-drop the NotEnoughItems .jar files we’ve downloaded into it. Luckily, modern modpack launchers make this quite easy CurseForge Open the CurseForge App and locate your modpack, then right-click on its thumbnail. Click Open Folder In the folder that opens, head into the mods subfolder. Drag-and-drop the downloaded .jar files into the mods subfolder. Don’t overwrite any files if it asks you. Technic Open the Technic Launcher and go to the Modpacks tab at the top, then click on your modpack. Click Modpack Options on the top right. Press Open button to the right of the directory listing. In the folder that opens, head into the mods subfolder. Drag-and-drop the downloaded .jar files into the mods subfolder. Don’t overwrite any files if it asks you. ATLauncher Open the ATLauncher and navigate to the Instances tab to the right of the launcher. Scroll down to your modpack and click Open Folder. In the folder that opens, head into the mods subfolder. Drag-and-drop the downloaded .jar files into the mods subfolder. Don’t overwrite any files if it asks you. Voidswrath Open the Voidswrath Launcher and locate your modpack. Click Advanced. Click Edit Mods. Drag-and-drop the downloaded .jar files into the mods subfolder. Don’t overwrite any files if it asks you. FTB Open the FTB launcher and navigate to the “My Modpacks” tab. Hover your mouse over your modpack and click on the three dots. To the top right of the page, click on Open Folder. In the folder that opens, head into the mods subfolder. Drag-and-drop the downloaded .jar files into the mods subfolder. Don’t overwrite any files if it asks you. And that’s all. Once you’ve successfully completed these steps, NotEnoughItems will launch alongside your modpack.Using NotEnoughItemsAs a StandaloneNotEnoughItems works right out of the box. To access its menu, simply open your inventory. You’ll be greeted by the item viewer. The buttons might look a little bit different on your end, depending on the version and settings, but the layout and functionality are the same. In case you’re playing singleplayer and your screen is missing the cheat and item preset buttons on the left-hand side, you will need to: Click Options on the bottom left Click Inventory Make sure the second option from the top is set to Cheat Mode Click Global on the top right Right-click on the W to the left of Cheat Mode And it will show as intended!To the right of the inventory is the bread and butter of NotEnoughItems — the item and recipe viewer. It lists all items, both from the base game and from any other mods you might have installed. To view an item’s recipe, simply hover your pointer over it and right-click! If you’d like to add the item do your inventory instead, left-click it. Changing the counter on the bottom of the item viewer changes the number of items you’ll be given. To navigate through the pages, you can either use the Prev and Next buttons found on top of the item list, or your mouse’s scroll wheel with your pointer hovering over the panel.The Item Subsets drop-down menu, found on top of the screen, lets you filter items. Left-click to enable an item or a group of items, right-click to disable.On the top left, you’ll see a collection of cheat buttons. If you’re playing on a server, these can only be used by an operator. Hovering over each one will show its function as a tooltip; pressing it will cause it to do its function — for example, set the world time to dusk, change the gamemode, or heal the player. Likewise, underneath the cheat buttons, you’ll find a list of item presets. By default, they’ll say Save, followed by their number in the list. Pressing on Save will save your current inventory layout, and pressing on the preset button — now named Load — will load it back in. To delete a preset you don’t want to use anymore, simply press X to the side of it. For servers, this is also an operator-only function.As an AddonAs an addon, NotEnoughItems plugs directly into JustEnoughItems and adds back its cheat and preset buttons. They’ll appear to the left side of your inventory, just as when it’s installed as a standalone, and behave in an identical way. Make sure to read through our JustEnoughItems guide! (JustEnoughItems guide link goes here!)To reiterate:The cheat buttons let you quickly enact some handy commands, such as changing the time of day, gamemode, or healing yourself. If you’re playing on a server, these are only usable by server operators.The preset buttons allow for saving and loading of inventory presets, so you can quickly go back and forth from one inventory state to another. Similarly, if you’re playing on a server, this is also only usable by operators.ConclusionMods are tools — whether they add new features to play around with, extend already existing ones, or provide options for more efficient gameplay, they’re there for the player. It’s important to know your options, and even more important to know how to effectively use them — and inventory mods, such as NotEnoughItems, are integral to this.Get started with your own minecraft server in 5 min and start trying out these great features.
